BARTON LIDICE BENES TOOLS IN PRINT

In this activity we'll be using Barton Benes process of paper-macheing found objects to create our own work of art!

Materials:

- Newspaper
- Cardboard
- Glue
- Water
- Bowl
- Popsicle stick
- Items from around your house
- · Hot glue gun



Instructions:

- 1. If you're using a cereal box, cut one side of the box off so that the box is open.
- 2. Mix your paper-mache glue by adding 1 part glue and 1 part water into a bowl and stirring well using your popsicle stick
- 3. Paper-mache the inside of your box, of if you're using cardboard, one side of the cardboard.
- 4. Set that aside and wait for it to dry.
- 5. Grab the objects you want to use in this work and paper-mache each of those. Set them aside to dry.
- 6. Once your objects are dry, grab your hot glue gun and a parent or guardian for help.
- 7. Arrange your objects in a pleasing composition, then one-by-one glue them in place.
- 8. Step back and admire your masterpiece!
